CONDITIONS:

1. Tires, fuel oil or similar materials which cause visible emissions, shall not be used to ignite or sustain an open fire.
2. A restricted open fire is allowed only when prevailing winds are away from populated areas. Fire shall be not started during heavy winds.
3. The permit holder shall not conduct open burning during any stage of an air pollution episode or when the State Commission of Environmental Conservation announces a period of high fire danger.
4. Material to be ignited shall be contained in an outside fireplace to prevent fire from spreading.
5. No fire shall be unattended at any time or be left unattended until entirely extinguished.
6. The permit holder shall be liable for damage to trees or other property resulting from fires ignited by the permit holder.
7. Should it be necessary to extinguish any fire, the permit holder shall pay the entire cost of suppression.
8. This permit is non-transferrable and may be suspended if the permit holder fails to comply with permit conditions as determined by the Code Enforcement Officer or Constable.
9. Restricted burning shall not cause contravention of any applicable ambient air quality standard or cause air pollution.
10. This permit is valid only where the permit holder owns the site of open fire or where holder has secured written permission from the site owner. This permit authorizes no trespass on private property.
11. Permit holder agrees to comply with Chapter 40 (Open Burning) of the Village of Dannemora's Code.
12. Burning of downed limbs and branches (including branches with attached leaves or needles) less than six (6) inches in diameter and eight (8) feet in length is prohibited from March 15th through May 15th. Small cooking or campfires less than three (3) feet in height and less than four (4) feet in length and width or diameter will still be allowed.
